

A.D. 1765. Anthony Mooyaart, born at Jaffna 6th December, 1698, died there 1st January, 1767, son of Nicolaas Mooyaart and Johanna van Eschweiler, and grandson of Anthony Mooyaart of Amsterdam and Maria Durhee. The branch at Holland is settled at Broek in Waterland.

Asym. Agent, a mermaid issuing from the sea and holding in her dexter arm a trident.

Crest. A trident as in the arms.

A.D. 1765. Iman Willem Falck, born at Colombo, 1738, died there 6th February, 1785, son of Frans Willem Falck of Cologne, Dissave of Matara, and Adriana Gobius of Samarang.

There is a picture of him in the Ryk's Museum at The Hague where he is represented giving audience (A.D. 1772) to the Kandyan Ambassadors. "At the head of the table" says the writer in Vol. II Journal of the Dutch Burgher Union p. 148 "in an elaborately carved and richly upholstered chair, wearing a three cornered hat, is seated Governor Iman Willem Falck."

Arms. Gules, a falcon essorant, or.

Crest. A falcon as in the arms. (Lapidarium Zeylanicum p. 30).

A.D. 1785. Willem Jacob van de Graaff, born at Heussen 28th May, 1737, son of Sebastian van de Graaff and Gertruida van Vinceler. His daughter married 1803 George Melville Leslie, C.C.S. son of the Earl of Leven.

Arms. Argent, two fesses battled-counter-embattled sable; on a canton or, a double eagle displayed sable. (Lapidarium Zeylanicum p. 13).
